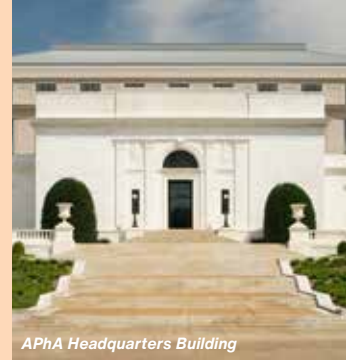
The APhA Foundation will also establish a recognition plaque inside of the APhA Headquarters Building to enshrine the names of all COVID-19 Heroes.



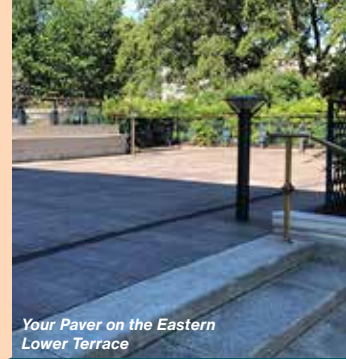
CONTRIBUTION LEVELS

A financial contribution at the level meaningful to you will support the COVID-19 Heroes Campaign and help fund our ability to conduct programs and develop resources to support public awareness of pharmacists' patient care services and improvement of public health.

- **\$1 - \$499**, will provide direct support for the campaign and you will be acknowledged as a donor to the Foundation in the annual report and online.
- **\$500 - \$999**, will enshrine your name as a supporter of the campaign on a bronze supporter plaque to be installed inside the APhA Headquarters building.
- **\$1,000**, will allow for the selection of your preferred 8" x 8" paver location, submission of an inscription, and recognition on the bronze campaign recognition plaque.
- **\$5,000**, for a larger 32" x 16" paver will allow for selection of your preferred paver location around the edge of the eastern lower terrace, submission of an inscription, and recognition on the bronze campaign recognition plaque.
- **\$15,000**, will allow for dedication of a bench overlooking the eastern lower terrace, submission of an inscription, and recognition on the bronze campaign recognition plaque. (Two available)
